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Kauai Bible College Rules

DRIVING/PARKING

- Driving through men’s/women’s camp is prohibited between **9:30 PM** and **7:00 AM**.
- Vehicles may only be parked in the designated parking area.
- The speed limit on the Camp Hale Koa property is **5 MPH**.
- Multiple violations of these rules will result in further restrictions of driving privileges.

SHOWER HOUSE/BATHROOMS

Shower House:

- Hot water is limited so please do not take unnecessarily long showers.
- Do not leave anything (shampoo, clothes, towel etc.) in the shower stall, on the sink, or on the window sill.
- You must be fully clothed when walking to and from the shower house.
- Do not use something that is not yours without permission.

Restroom:

- Do not flush anything other than toilet paper or human waste.
- Do not leave the hose on the ground.
- Replace toilet paper if you are the one to use the last of the roll.

CABINS

- Be gentle with the doors. Do not slam them.
- Close windows during heavy rain pour or when you know you will be gone most of the day.
- Remove shoes/slippers before entering any cabin. Also, make sure to wash dirty feet and sand off body before entering cabins as well as any objects entering cabins.
- Keep the cabin tidy and clean.
- Vacuum once a week.
- Campus quiet time is **9:30PM**.
- Everyone needs to be dressed modestly at all times. Refer to school dress code.

KITCHEN

- Visitors are not allowed to use the kitchen facilities without permission. You may however store food in the kitchen as long as it is sealed.
